
REFEREE is a user-friendly tool that helps you measure and visualize the multiple benefits of energy efficiency.

#### What is Referee?

Referee is an online decision-support tool for energy efficiency measures. It will quantify the multiple benefits of energy efficiency, e.g. in terms of productivity, socioeconomic development, wellbeing, environment and climate.



You work in local government. You would like to take action to promote smart energy management for heating in the residential sector.

You can use the Referee tool to assess the multiple benefits of energy efficiency measures, in terms of:

#### How does it work?

REFEREE builds on E3ME, a macroeconometric model designed to address national and global economic and economy-environment policy challenges. Newly built technology diffusion models will assess the deployment of technologies in response to policy interventions in three sectors: road transport, housing and industrial demand for heat.





### For whom?

The tool will be accessible to everyone: no specific software or modelling skills are required. Whether you work at local, regional or national level, energy or non-energy fields, you will be able to see the multiple benefits of energy efficiency.
